### Registration for the NY Thespian Festival, "Medieval Times," is now open!

NY Thespians is thrilled to invite you to the 15th Annual NY State Thespian Festival, a celebration of school theater in the Empire State! This year's event will take place March 8-9, 2025 on the campus of Long Island University- Brooklyn, just an 8-minute walk from Atlantic Station LIRR and minutes away from multiple subway lines.

Please note that registration closes February 15th. Workshop choices will open February 10th and close February 15th. You and your students have the opportunity to take part in the following:

- Workshops in acting, musical theater, dance, directing, and technical theater
- Thespys (formerly known as Individual Events) students can perform published work for feedback and awards! Categories include acting, musical theatre performance, musical theatre dance, light design, scenic (set) design, sound design, makeup design, costume design, costume construction, stage management, short film, playwriting, and theatre marketing (publicity). Check out the guidelines and rubrics HERE. NY Thespians has put together checklists for each event HERE.
- *Play-in-a-Day* students can opt in to be a playwright, director, actor, or crew for our second annual play-in-a-day showcase! With guidance from professionals, students will write, act, direct, and tech a short series of 10-minute plays. Staged readings will take place Sunday afternoon.
- STO (State Thespian Officer) Workshop we are looking for incredible student leaders to plan next year's festival, develop service and advocacy projects, and represent their corner of NY State!

Festival will take place March 8-9, 2025 at LIU-Brooklyn, 1 University Plaza, Brooklyn, NY. Please find a copy of the festival schedule for your perusal.

In addition, we are looking for fabulous 75-minute workshops geared toward middle and high school students and their teachers. We are also looking for adjudicators to judge monologues, duet scenes, musical theatre performances, and technical portfolios. We pay a \$75 honorarium for all workshops and up to \$50 for all adjudicators, depending on the task.

Student groups write, produce, and perform a play over the course of the weekend. (OPTIONAL) Put together a team of 3-5 people for our Improv Competition! No experience necessary, but it does help to have familiarity with the games that will be played. An explanation of this event appears later in this packet. Winners get the opportunity to perform for all attendees. (OPTIONAL) Put together a team of 4-6 people for our Tech Challenge! Groups of students from schools/groups compete in 4-5 backstage skills challenges, outlined in this packet.

<sup>\*\*-</sup> The One Act performances are scheduled Saturday afternoon. Regional winners will be presenting their shows. Competitions take place on Saturdays or Sundays in November and December.

\*\*\*- Thespys are "International Thespian Excellence Awards." These include monologues (2 contrasting, 3 minutes max.), duet scenes, group scenes, solo musical singing, duet musical singing, group musical singing, light design, set design, sound design, costume design, costume construction, makeup, publicity, short film, animated film, documentary and stage management. Thespys will only be adjudicated on Friday for middle school and Saturday for high school. Rubrics are available through this link and on the NY Thespians website. Students may present in up to three different categories.

### Broadway has the TONYS, Hollywood has the OSCARS, Thespians have the THESPYS!

The International Thespian Excellence Awards, or Thespys<sup>™</sup> for short, recognize the highest level of achievement in school theatre performance and technical theatre.

This educational program (formerly National Individual Events) gives Thespians — students who have been inducted into the International Thespian Society — the opportunity to receive constructive feedback on prepared theatrical material and technical designs. Students who achieve overall Superiors receive special recognition at Festival as well as a medal and certificate. All students who participate receive written feedback from two to three professionals in the field.

Students can opt to participate in up to three categories for \$5 each submission. If a Thespian is unable to attend Festival and wants to participate in Thespys, they can upload their performance and/or presentation to Open Water for \$15 each Thespy.

### GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL CATEGORIES - see NY THESPIANS CHECKLISTS HERE

- All Thespys will be performed or presented LIVE
- Musical Theatre Thespys must have their music prepared to be played through a bluetooth, lightning, or 1/4" audio-enabled device (students are encouraged to bring their own devices to play music)
- Wear all black or dark clothing (students may elect to bring a change of clothes), NO PROPS, NO COSTUMES, NO THEATRICAL MAKEUP
- Stick to the allocated time for the category
- Follow all category rules and expectations

### Play-in-a-Day Showcase at NY Thespian Festival 2025



Any student attending the NY Thespian Festival can sign up to participate in Play-in-a-Day. This is a creative event where students from all over NY State get together to write, direct, perform, and tech short 10-minute plays in one weekend. This is an activity that can be easily replicated at your school for a fun night of low-stakes theater or even a major fundraiser!

### February 5-14, sign up:

• Students who want to write, direct, act, or be on crew sign up during workshop sign-up February 5-14. Everyone will meet together at 10am on March 8th.

### March 3-7:

 Any student attending Festival can submit ONE LINE that must be used by every playwright in their show. They can also vote on a prop that must be included.

### Saturday, March 8th

- 10am: **ALL INVOLVED** will meet together and be randomly divided into teams of 1 playwright, 1 director, and equal numbers of actors; technicians will work together to support all teams. The line and prop that must appear in every show will be revealed. Teams will have 15 minutes to plan together.
- Workshop #1, lunch, and All-Festival time: **PLAYWRIGHTS** will be given dedicated writing time with support from the Play-in-a-Day team. These students will eat lunch together and take part in the All-Festival Activity in a special Writers' Room. They will then resume a regular Festival schedule beginning at Workshop #2.
- Activity time: ACTORS and DIRECTORS will meet to have a read-through of their scripts and begin blocking.
- Dinner Time: **ACTORS and DIRECTORS** will rehearse, providing notes for **CREW**. We are aware that some students may not be able to stay late for this rehearsal. Students may still participate, even if they are unable to attend this extra rehearsal time!

### Sunday, March 9th

- 9am: **ALL INVOLVED** will meet together to go over any notes, changes, and ideas. Show performance order will be determined.
- Lunch time: **ACTORS and DIRECTORS** will have their final rehearsal, providing notes for **CREW**.
- 1:05pm: Performances and accolades!



# Improv Competition and Tech Challenge at NY Thespian Festival 2025



### IMPROV COMPETITION:

Troupes/schools/groups may send teams of 3-5 students to compete in a series of improv games and scenes. All groups will receive feedback from adjudicators. One group will be selected to showcase a game during an All-Festival time.

Your group may choose to practice beforehand or just jump in the day of the event. All participants should at least familiarize themselves with the procedures of each game. The link to game choices and explanations can be found <u>AT THIS LINK</u>. The run of the event is outlined below:

- 1. Warm-up with all teams:
  - a. 10 Things
  - b. Pass the clap
  - c. What are you doing?
- 2. Short Game, each team. Everyone will play two of these games. Each team gets to select their own games. Before the first round, each team introduces their team name and leader/host. Game options:
  - а
- 3. Long Game, each team. One game will be played. Each team gets to select their own game.
- 4. Tiebreaker Game (if necessary), any teams
- 5. Extra time = group games for all! Led by adjudicators

### **TECH CHALLENGE:**

Troupes/groups may send teams of 4-6 students to compete in a series of five technical challenges. Each event is designed to demonstrate as closely as possible the techniques and practices used in the professional theatre industry.

Participants should feel free to ask questions of the adjudicators in each event to help clarify rules or procedures before they compete. However, that is not the time to ask to be taught how to do an event. Participants are also strongly encouraged to watch, cheer for, and support other teams during the competition.

- Light hang and focus
- Leg a platform
- Costume guick change and sew a button
- Set up a prop table and coil a cable
- Spike a set
